## Location

## **Rectory Park, Ealing, UB5 6BB**

Rectory Park is a 30 minute walk or 10 minute bus from Northolt station on the London Underground Central Line.

Closest bus routes are 140, 190, 120, SL9, 282, 696, E7 and E9. The 140, 190, 120 and SL9 run past Northolt station.

Closest train station is South Greenford. The E6, E7 and E9 run past South Greenford station.

We will meet in the area marked in orange on the map below. The park can be accessed from Church Road, Parkfield Drive, Ruislip Road or Rectory Park Avenue.
