Activity details	<p>Activity: We will be planting small trees in the park to create new forest areas. The activity involves digging, using a wheelbarrow, using hand tools and some lifting.</p> <p>Background: This planting day is part of a larger planting project to add more trees to the Borough of Ealing. The new trees will provide succession to the mature trees already in Ravenor Park as well as increasing wildlife habitat and help to combat climate change by sequestering carbon and cooling the air.
